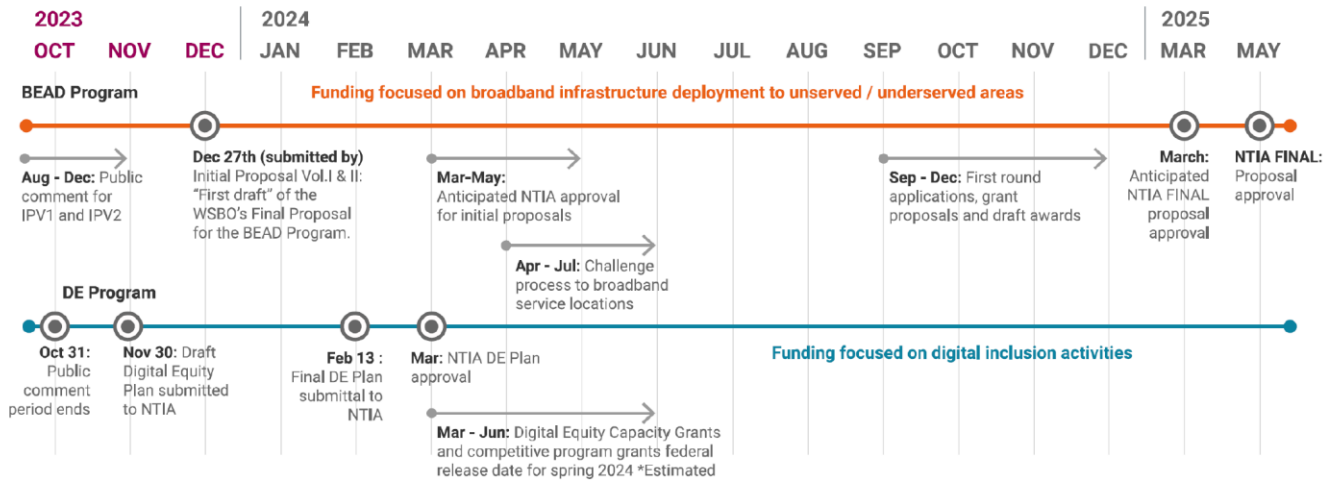

## BEAD Timeline

# Program submission requirements and timeline

Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) Program and Digital Equity (DE) Program – complementary programs running in parallel



### Definition of Roles

Funding Entity – NTIA  
Eligible Entity – States  
Subgrantees – Tribes, Public Entities, Internet Services Providers (ISPs)

### Match (25% Minimum of Proposal Total)

Washington State Tribes and Public Entities (only) - \$50 Million (2024) \$150 Million (through 2028 anticipated)  
ARP SLFRF Broadband Match Eligible Category (5.21) – per county direction  
- Obligation requirement by 12/31/2024  
- Expenditure requirement by 12/31/2026
