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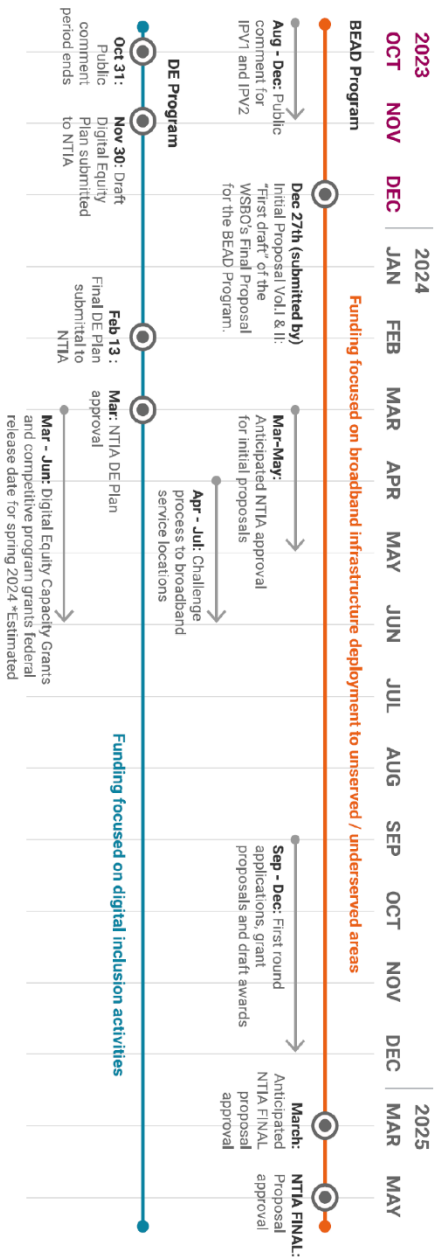


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Program submission requirements and timeline

Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) Program and Digital Equity (DE) Program – complementary programs running in parallel



- Definition of Roles**
- Funding Entity – NNTA
 - Eligible Entity – States
 - Subgrantees – Tribes, Public Entities, Internet Services Providers (ISPs)
- Match (25% Minimum of Proposal Total)**
- Washington State Tribes and Public Entities (only) - \$50 Million (2024) \$150 Mil (through 2028 anticipated)
 - ARR SIFRF Broadband Match Eligible Category (5.21) – per county direction
 - Obligation requirement by 12/31/2024
 - Expenditure requirement by 12/31/2026
