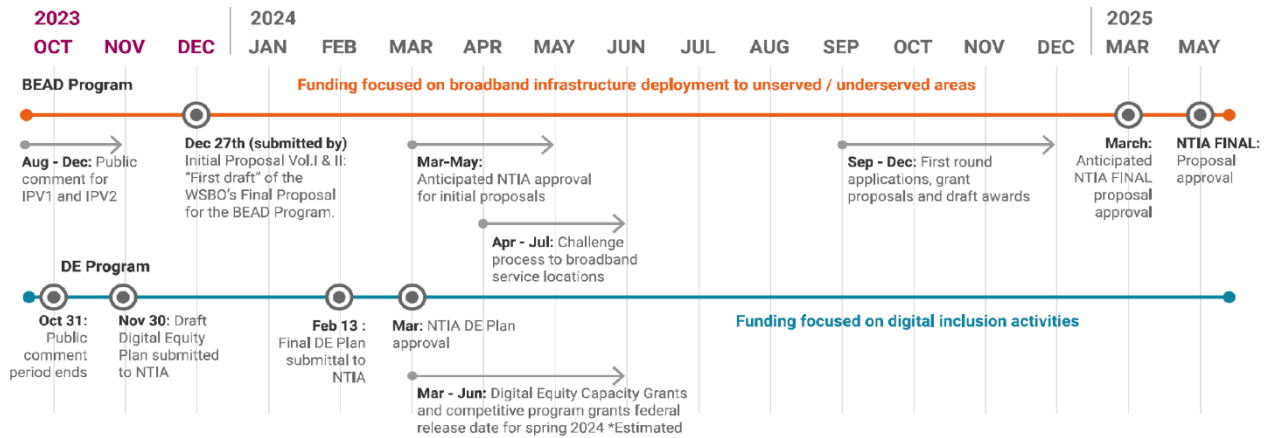

BEAD Timeline

Program submission requirements and timeline

Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) Program and Digital Equity (DE) Program – complementary programs running in parallel



Definition of Roles

- Funding Entity – NTIA
- Eligible Entity – States
- Subgrantees – Tribes, Public Entities, Internet Services Providers (ISPs)

Match (25% Minimum of Proposal Total)

- Washington State Tribes and Public Entities (only) - \$50 Million (2024) \$150 Million (through 2028 anticipated)
- ARP SLFRF Broadband Match Eligible Category (5.21) – per county direction
 - Obligation requirement by 12/31/2024
 - Expenditure requirement by 12/31/2026
